Quebec Indigenous Research Chair in Nursing's scholarship for masters and doctoral students

The mission of the Quebec Indigenous Research Chair in Nursing (CRASIQ) is to promote health equity and cultural safety for Indigenous peoples in Quebec through the decolonization of health professionals' education and practice. The CRASIQ will award scholarships to students whose research projects are related to one of the following axes:

1. Build health professional's capacity to become culturally safe practitioners who decolonize their practice
2. Developing wise practices at the structural level to support equity-promoting and culturally safe health care for Indigenous Peoples

Dr. Amélie Blanchet Garneau has held the Chair since 2019 and is an assistant professor in the Faculty of Nursing at the Université de Montréal. She is a regular researcher at the Centre de recherche en santé publique (CRéSP). CRASIQ is funded by the Canadian Institutes of Health Research, the Fonds de recherche en Santé du Québec, the Canadian Nurses Foundation and the Université de Montréal.

Amounts of \$20,000 for PhD students and \$10,000 for Master's students will be awarded for one year, subject to the availability of funds, for the completion of student research projects. Although this scholarship is not renewable, it can be obtained a maximum of three times for doctoral students and twice for master's students, depending on the availability of funds.

QUEBEC INDIGENOUS RESEARCH CHAIR IN NURSING'S SCHOLARSHIP FOR MASTERS AND DOCTORAL STUDENTS

ELIGIBILITY

- Be enrolled in a Master's or a Phd program in one of Quebec's universities
- Carry out a research project that falls within one of CRASIQ's research axis

SELECTION AND EVALUATION

- Quality of the research project
 - Clarity and conciseness of the problematic
 - Clarity and concordance of the research objectives
 - Appropriateness of the method(s)
 - Originality of the project and contribution to the advancement of knowledge in Indigenous health research
 - Respect for the principles of Indigenous research
- Alignment of the research project with the Chair's mission and its research axes
- Excellence of the academic record
- Research experience
- Grants and awards
- Publications and communications
- A letter of support from a professor in the program

DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED (ELECTRONIC COPY)

- Completed and signed scholarship application form
- A copy of University transcripts of completed studies and ongoing studies
- Description of the research project (problem, goal, method, expected outcomes, timeline) --- maximum 2 pages including references, single line spacing, font size 12 (Times New Roman), margins 2.5 cm
- A Curriculum Vitae including relevant research experience, grants and awards, list of publications, conference presentations and other outreach activities to date (4 pages maximum, single-spaced, Times New Roman 12, 2.5 cm margins)
- A letter of motivation (1 page)
- A letter of support from a professor in the program

GRANTING CONDITIONS

- To pursue their studies in a Master's or PhD program in one of Quebec's universities
- To mention CRASIQ in oral or written communications related to their project
- To present their work at a CRASIQ scientific activity
- The cumulation of scholarships is permitted up to a maximum of 60 000\$.
- Award recipients agree to apply for awards from external funding agencies (e.g. RRISIIQ, FRQS, FRQSC, SSHRC, CIHR).

METHOD OF PAYMENT

Payment of the scholarship is made in three equal installments (one per trimester) for a total of 20 000\$ for the doctoral scholarship and 10 000\$ for the master's scholarship.

SUBMISSION OF THE APPLICATION
